Students learn a wide range of practical engineering skills including:

- Engineering Calculations: geometrics, cost estimates, & quantities
- Report Writing and Engineering Documentation
- Microstation Drafting

In addition, students are educated on current Design & Construction practices for NDDOT projects. Student Design Assistants are trained in geometric highway design through real world transportation projects.

Students are required to work 40 hours per week during the summer (12-20 hours per week during the semester) and have the ability to communicate ideas clearly and concisely both orally and in writing.

Ideal candidates would possess leadership, prioritization, and time management skills; they would be self-directed, highly motivated, detail oriented, and possess logical decision making and analytical skills.
