

DBE Special Provision Modifications—Quick Tip #4

Effective for the March 18, 2016 Bid Opening, both DBE Special Provisions – Race/Gender Conscious (RGC) and Race/Gender Neutral (RGN) SPs will change.

Remember, ALL JOBS CONTAINING FEDERAL HIGHWAY FUNDING are “DBE JOBS.”

All DBE participation counts toward the DBE goal.

A Liaison Meeting will be held the week of February 22 to discuss the upcoming changes.

The major differences facing contractors:

- **Deadlines:**

Deadline for all supporting documentation for project containing either SP changes to 7 calendar days. The Department is allowing up to 4 p.m. the 7th day after a bid opening for submission of the necessary paperwork. On January 1, 2017, the allowable time is reduced to 5 calendar days.

- **Seven calendar days:**

Primes bidding on RGC projects having not met the project goal at the time of bid have until 4 p.m. on the 7th day after a bid opening to meet the goal or submit appropriate Good Faith Efforts documentation as spelled out in the RGC SP.

- **Sign-In System:**

All contractors, primes, subcontractors regardless of the dollar value of their quotes, suppliers, regular dealers, etc. may now use the Bid Opening Sign-in System. The web address of the system has not changed.

- a. The sign-in system remains a requirement for primes and large subcontractors on RGC projects. Signing in is STRONGLY encouraged for primes and large subcontractors on RGN projects.
- b. The sign-in system is now open for ALL quoters to sign in and indicate their interest in performing highway construction work.
- c. The sign-in system is available for viewing or printing throughout the sign-in period. The sign-in period closes at 11 AM CT the day before each bid opening.

- **DBE Advertisement System:**

- a. Advertisement remains a requirement for primes and large subcontractors on RGC projects. Advertising is strongly encouraged for primes and large subcontractors on RGN projects.
- b. A web-based DBE Advertisement System replaces the requirement of advertising in the DBE Newsletter. Use of the DBE Advertisement System is required 15 days before each bid opening.
- c. A new direct contact option replaces the newspaper advertisement option.
 - ◆ If the contractor misses 15-day deadline for advertisement, a new option allows them to directly contact DBEs no later than 7 calendar days before the bid opening.

PRICING RESOURCES FOR CONTRACTORS

ANNUAL AVERAGE BID PRICE LIST

As a contractor, how would you know the average cost of items let to bid through the NDDOT?

In a recent discussion regarding competition in highway construction, the question was asked “how do we know whether our pricing strategies are realistic?”

One resource on the Department’s website may provide some context.

From each bid opening, the Department calculates the average prices bid according to spec/code pay items. The list is found at: <http://www.dot.nd.gov/pacer/AABP2015E.pdf>. This list gives contractors a ball-park figure on the Department’s average cost of performing the full pay item.

Example: An erosion control firm is looking for the average price of seeding per acre. The average price of Seeding Class I is \$885.49 per acre (January 11, 2016 list). This price takes into consideration the total cost of seed, equipment, materials, and labor paid to the contractor for providing the seeding service according to the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction (see Section 251 starting on page 159 for the seed class mix and other requirements).

Disclaimer: The prices do not reflect partial pay items such as hauling of milling, aggregate, or asphalt cement. This story is not meant to imply that a business owner should determine their costs and pricing based on this list.

ABSTRACT OF BIDS RECEIVED


Another way to determine how your quotes stacked up against the competition is to review the Abstract of Bids Received. The abstract compares the bids received in low to high price order by job by bid opening.

Example: Navigate to

<http://www.dot.nd.gov/pacer/bidopenrptIndex.html> and select

a bid opening date from the drop down menu. The abstract allows contractors to review the prices bid by primes on the job’s work items.

Quoters can visually compare their own prices to prices bid for each item by the prime. The Abstract may be viewed, printed, or saved to your computer. This is generally a very large file, so you may opt to print only the jobs you’re interested in.

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
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
