

WHAT WILL IT COST YOU?

A DUI can cost up to \$10,000

FOLLOWING ARE POTENTIAL EXPENSES FOR A FIRST OFFENSE

Fine (minimum)	\$250
Towing, impound	\$110
Mandatory alcohol evaluation	\$300
Victim Impact Panel	\$40
Driver's license reinstatement	\$100
Lawyer and court fees	\$2,500
High-risk insurance premiums (\$2,200 per year for three years)	\$6,600

Nearly \$10,000*

*This is an estimate. Individual circumstances may vary.

PENALTIES FOR DUI CONVICTION ARE SERIOUS

Fine/Jail Time /Loss of License

1st: Up to \$1,000/ Up to 30 days/ 91-180 days

2nd: Up to \$1,000/ Up to 30 days/ 1-2 years

3rd: Up to \$2,000/ Up to 1 year/ 2-3 years

4th: Up to \$2,000/ Up to 1 year/ 2-3 years

5th: Up to \$5,000/ Up to 5 years/ 2-3 years*

*The license is restored only after completion of substance abuse treatment and no alcohol-related offenses in the two years after completion of treatment.

The legal blood alcohol content limit in North Dakota is:

0.08 for drivers over 21 years old

0.02 for drivers under 21 years old

0.04 for commercial drivers

DUI includes alcohol, intoxicants, narcotics or prescription drugs that influence the central nervous system.
