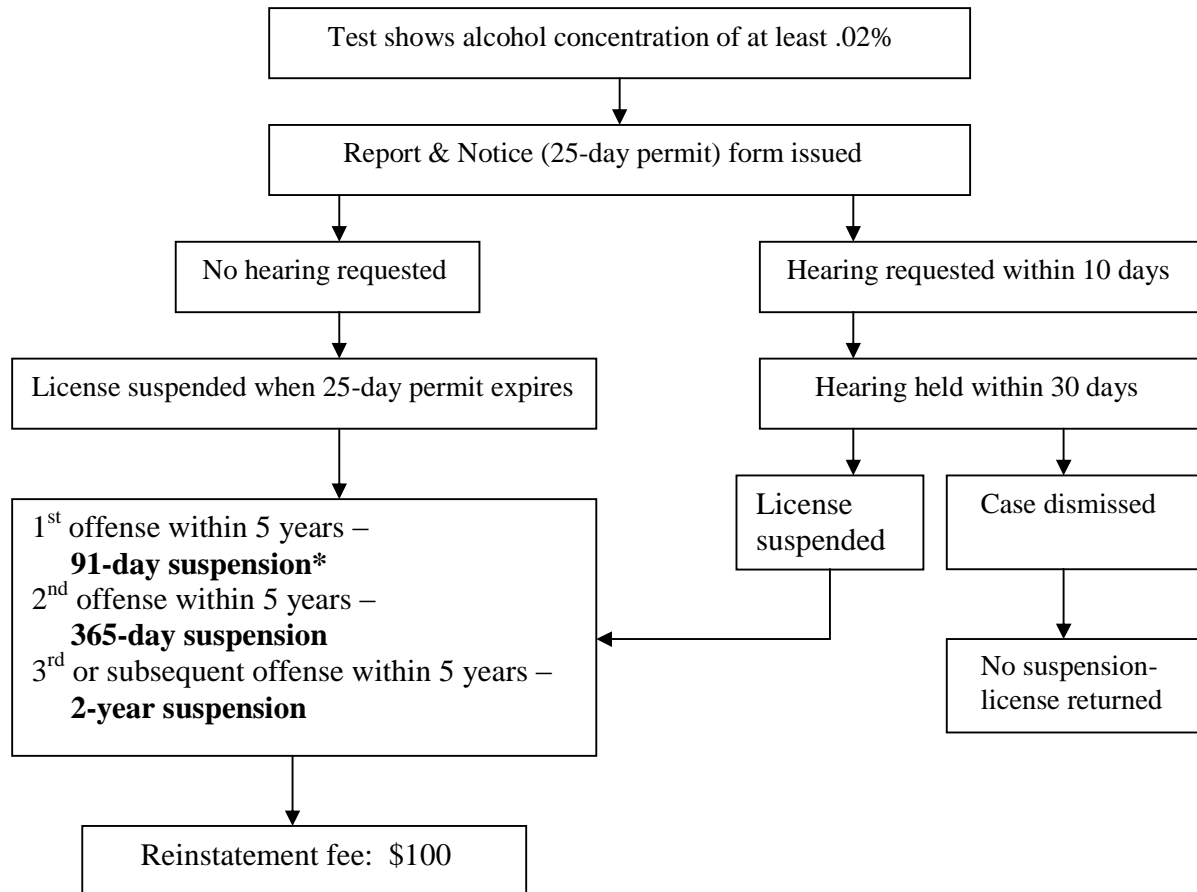


NDDOT “ZERO TOLERANCE” ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS FOR PERSONS UNDER AGE 21 YEARS WITH ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION OF .02 % TO .07 %



*A person who is at least 18 years of age might be eligible for a temporary restricted license, which is also called a "work permit." A work permit may be issued to a North Dakota resident licensed in North Dakota after 30 days of suspension if all requirements are met. This applies only if the violation was the first within five years.

A work permit will **not** be issued to a person who is less than 18 years old.

Also, if a person is less than 18 years of age the law requires cancellation of the person's license or permit. This means a person under age 18 must complete all requirements for obtaining a new license. This includes passing the written test to obtain an instruction permit, holding the instruction permit for six months, successfully completing an approved course of driver training instruction, passing the driving test and paying all required fees.
