

## ***Draft 2017 State Management Plan for Public Transportation ready for public comment***

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) has published a draft of the State Management Plan for Public Transportation and is available for comment from October 16, 2017 to November 15, 2017. This Plan is a document which describes the state policies and procedures for administering the various Federal Transit Administration (FTA) program funds and state funds for public transportation. This document also is an information source for disseminating transit information to the general public and all other interested parties.
