**NOTICE OF GOAL
FOR DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PARTICIPATION IN
TRANSPORTATION RELATED PROJECTS**

Goal-setting for disadvantaged business enterprises (DBEs) with capabilities in the transportation industry is required by 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 26. The following goal is applicable for the 2017-2019 federal fiscal years (October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2019)

2017-2019 FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION DBE GOAL: 1.25 PERCENT

This goal represents the percentage of work to be accomplished by DBE prime contractors, subcontractors, consultants, vendors, and material suppliers for professional services, construction, and procurement contracts on federal-aid transit projects and grants.
