

Guidelines for Community Wayfinding Signage

Community wayfinding signs are part of a coordinated and continuous system of signs that direct tourists and other road user to key civic, cultural, visitor, and recreational attractions and other destinations within a city or a local urbanized or downtown area.

Cities considering wayfinding signing shall provide a Master Plan to the NDDOT and FHWA before any roadway plans are developed. The Master Plan will need to be approved to ensure that all state and federal guidelines are being followed.
