REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND POLICY

NEW FOR 2018-2019

A new registration system was created in 2018. You may now register for both ND Technical Certification courses and Erosion and Sediment Control Certification (ESCC) through one system. See the ESCC website for more information. [ESCC](#)

Students that completed courses in either program now have one Tech ID. If you previously attended a course you have a TechID. Please use your Tech ID when registering for a course. You may verify your ID at [this link](#). Some names are similar, if you have questions about your Tech ID email Sharon at dotmaterials@nd.gov

The ESCC courses are coordinated with the ND Association of General Contractors (AGC) office. The TCP courses continue to be coordinated with Dakota Asphalt Pavement Association (DAPA). Payments are separate for ESCC and ND TCP courses. Each program has their own policy regarding pre-payment requirements, cancellation policy and possible refunds.

*Credit Card payment are now available for ND TCP courses for the 2018-2019 classes.

Always verify that you receive a confirmation email. It is your verification of registration and also provides a link for credit card payment information.

REGISTRATION

All registration is through the TCP website. The class sizes are limited. Early registration is always suggested.

Please do not register individuals in the effort to 'hold' a seat or register individuals that have already completed the course and have current certification. We attempt to accommodate all *reasonable* registration requests.

Please provide accurate student contact information when registering. The reply email you receive when registering is the only confirmation you will receive. While we make every effort to provide a reminder notice close to the date of the class that does not always happen

Registrations fees are expected prior to the class date. If payment is not received the seat in the class may be released. Checks should be made payable to DAPA and mailed to 3030 Airport Road, Pierre, SD 57501. Credit card payment option is also available through DAPA. Use the link provided in the registration confirmation email.

LODGING & MEALS

Registrants are responsible for their own meals and lodging. The hotel where the courses are held offers a block of rooms. Hotel policies differ but generally rooms in a block are held for two weeks up to one month prior to the start of the class - or until the block of is filled. Numerous other hotels are available in the area.

STUDENT CANCELLATION POLICY

Students cancelling at least seven 7 calendar days prior to the class will receive a full refund.

Less than 7 days of the class, or a No-Show - no refund will be granted.

Companies may send a substitute to a class, but only under the approval of the TCP. If a student fails to attend a class without providing notice they surrender the full registration fee.

COURSE RESCHEDULING AND CANCELLATION

NDDOT and DAPA reserves the right to reschedule and/or cancel classes due to insufficient registrations or unexpected situations such as extreme weather. Students registered in that class will be notified and offered an alternative date or a refund if requested.

RETESTING

Students that do not pass a course but qualify for a Retest may schedule the exam through the NDDOT by calling 701-328-6937

Retesting must be completed by April 30 of the training season.

TEST OUT - RECIPROCIY POLICY

TEST OUT

Testing out of a course is allowed in some circumstances. See the Test Out policy found on the TCP website.

RECIPROCIY

Acceptance of certification from another state or - reciprocity is allowed in some circumstances. See the Reciprocity policy found on the TCP website.

By asking to test-out or request reciprocity individuals are stating that they have broad knowledge of the material, proficient in that area and have recent construction work experience in that area.
