What alternatives are being studied?

The following alternatives will be moving forward for further analysis.

- Alternative 1: Build: Re-Align the route down 11.5 Ave. SE and connect to 3rd St NE.
 - This alternate would include the purchase of ROW from BNSF.
- Alternative 2: Build: Re-Align the route down 11th Ave. SE and connect to 3rd St. NE.
 - This alternate would include the purchase of ROW from BNSF and a portion of another property.
- Alternative 3: 12th Ave. alignment would remain unchanged, and the existing section would be to be paved.
 - Likely exceptions with the NDDOT, FHWA, and BNSF would be needed to move forward with this alternate. Alternative 3 would not meet the project's purpose and need.
- Alternative 4: No Build

What is the purpose of the project?


The purpose of the proposed project is to address the roadway deficiencies along the project corridor and improve safety for the traveling public.
