# 9TH STREET NE 2025 RECONSTRUCTION

A reconstruction project beginning in 2025 will improve 9th Street NE from Main Avenue to 12th Avenue NE and 7th Avenue from 9th Street NE to east of the city line. This project is a result of a 2019 transportation study which identified the reconstruction and urbanization of this area as a high priority in the metro. The goal of this project is to improve the safety and quality of the roadway. This will be accomplished through:

- Pedestrian facilities
- Street lighting
- Railroad crossing upgrades
- Stormwater drainage
- Additional city utility modifications
- Urban section with curb and gutter

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

## When will construction happen?

Tentatively scheduled to start in the 2025 construction season.

# Will access to businesses and residential areas be maintained during construction?

**Yes.** Access to businesses and residential areas will be maintained or available through alternative routes during construction.

## Will easements or right of way be needed?

**Currently unknown.** We are only in the preliminary design stages of the project. We expect there may be some easements and right of way needed. Current plans anticipate a phased approach which will close sections of the roadway during construction. We will work with business owners and communicate through design and construction to ensure access.

#### How will this reconstruction be paid for?

Funding for this project is a combination of federal and local funds. Grant funding for grade separation at the railroad crossing has been applied for and if received would be awarded in the spring. Funding sources include the North Dakota Department of Transportation and City of West Fargo. The city's share may be paid through sales tax revenue and special assessments.
