

# **NDDOT** EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL CONSTRUCTION • TRAINING PROGRAM 2016-17

While erosion is a natural process, it is accelerated by construction activities. Each year, many acres of land in North Dakota are exposed during the course of construction and land development activities. Without properly installed protective measures before, during, and after construction, the land is left open for erosion and sediment runoff. Preventing sediment-laden runoff not only protects our rivers, lakes, and streams, but it also promotes clean water and environmental stewardship.

The NDDOT Erosion and Sediment Control Construction course serves to educate and inform construction personnel on the regulations, specifications, erosion and sediment control measures, and SWPPP development that apply to and best serve construction personnel in effectively managing assigned construction projects.

### **Topics include:**

- Regulations & special provisions
- Temporary and permanent erosion and sediment control measures
- SWPPP
- Project management

### Who should attend:

The primary audience for this course consists of public and private roadway construction management and inspection personnel, contractors responsible for installing erosion and sediment control devices and developing/implementing SWPPPs, and local government personnel.

\*This certification is mandatory for NDDOT and consultants working on NDDOT construction projects.
