No Travel Advisory lifted for northwestern North Dakota

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have **LIFTED** the **No Travel Advisory** for northwestern North Dakota including the cities of Williston, Watford City, Crosby and Stanley.

There is still a **No Travel Advisory** in portions of central and northeastern North Dakota due to blowing and drifting snow creating hazardous driving conditions. Cities included in the **No Travel Advisory** are: Jamestown, Valley City, Ellendale, Devils Lake, Grand Forks, Drayton, Minot, and surrounding areas. Motorists in these areas should **not travel** as blowing and drifting snow is creating near zero visibility and hazardous driving conditions.
