Water on roadways - ND Highway 52, approx. 12 miles east of Velva and ND Highway 20 near Webster, approx. 20 miles north of Devils Lake

Motorists are asked to use caution and reduce speeds on the following highways due to water on the roadways:

- ND Highway 52, approximately 12 miles east of Velva
- ND Highway 20 near Webster, approximately 20 miles north of Devils Lake

Traffic is currently being allowed on these highways. This means traffic control is in place and the road remains open, but motorists should use caution when traveling through the area.

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. Due to high water near roadways in many areas across the state, motorists are encouraged to use caution while traveling, vehicles that leave the roadway may become immersed in high water.
