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## **NDDOT seeks comments on 2010 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2010-2013 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of a following previously-unpublished Urban, Non – Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Area project in 2010.

### Urban City Project

Traffic Signal System Improvement Project at nine intersections in Dickinson:

- ND 22 & Broadway
- ND 22 & Villard St.
- ND 22 & 2nd Street West
- ND 22 & 3rd Street West
- ND 22 & 4th Street West
- ND 22 & 9th Street West
- Villard St. & State Avenue
- Villard St. & Sims Street
- Sims St. & 1st Street

Total Cost: \$200,000

The project includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Replacement of controller bases and cabinets.
- Replacement of components in the controller cabinets.
- Replacement of Pre-emption devices on signal standards.
- Software as needed for the new controllers and components.
- Laptop computer and software for the City to be able to communicate with the controllers.
