Public Input Meeting to be held on December 4 to discuss proposed improvements to the Campus Road Bridge on the University of North Dakota Campus

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. on December 4, 2012 at the Memorial Union Lecture Bowl, 2901 University Ave in Grand Forks. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 4:30 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements to the bridge over the English Coulee on Campus Road between Stanford Road and Centennial Drive. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input and discussion. Representatives of the University of North Dakota (UND), Advanced Engineering & Environmental Services (AE2S), and North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will be present to answer questions.
