Construction work to begin on ND Highway 23 west of New Town

Construction work will begin in April on ND Highway 23 west of New Town. Work consists of replacing the temporary surface with a permanent asphalt overlay providing a smoother driving surface. The project will begin on the west side of New Town and continue approximately nine miles west near the junction of ND Highway 22. This project is the final phase of the reconstruction project which began last year and included the addition of passing and turning lanes on the roadway.

During the project:

- Speeds will be reduced
- A width restriction of 12 feet will be in place
- Motorists may experience minimal delays

The project is expected to last approximately one month.

The traveling public should use caution when traveling through the construction zone. Motorists should allow extra distance between their vehicle and the vehicles in front of them, use extra caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
