Construction work begins Monday on the southwest exit ramp at Exit 161 on I-94 in Bismarck

Construction will begin Monday, June 18 on the southwest exit ramp at Exit 161 on I-94 in Bismarck. Work consists of widening the ramp to include an additional right turn lane.

During construction:

- The ramp will be narrowed to allow for construction work, however the left and right turn lanes will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.
- Interim traffic signals will be utilized on Bismarck Expressway adjacent to the ramp, which will close one lane in each direction on Bismarck Expressway for a few days.
- Speeds will be reduced.
- Motorists may experience brief delays.
- Motorists should use caution as trucks will be entering and exiting the work site.

The project is expected to be completed in July.

The traveling public should use caution when driving through the construction zone. Motorists should allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicles in front of them, use extra caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
