NDDOT seeks comments on 2012 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is seeking comments on an amendment to the 2012-2015 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for inclusion of this previously-unpublished project in 2012.

State Project:

1. US Highway 85 – Preliminary Engineering to consider upgrading US Highway 85 between I-94 and south of Watford City to a four lane roadway.

Total Cost for Preliminary Engineering: \$3,500,000
