Motorists reminded to bring identification card when titling or registering motor vehicles

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) reminds motorists when titling and registering vehicles to please bring identification. State law requires all applicants to use their legal name when titling or registering a vehicle. Your legal name can be verified by providing one of the following:

- A valid current state-issued driver's license
- A current non-driver identification card
- Current Military ID
- Other documentary evidence that confirms the true legal identity of the owner.
Example: Valid Foreign Passport with an I-94 card or an I-551 stamp
