A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. CDT on October 1 at the Beulah Civic Center. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 5:30 pm CDT.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for ND 49 from the Morton County Line north to Beulah. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) personnel will be in attendance to answer questions.
