I-94 westbound traffic to be detoured onto Exit Ramp 205 east of Steele during construction project

Beginning Monday, October 1, westbound traffic on Interstate 94 will be detoured onto the Robinson Interchange ramp at Exit 205 east of Steele. This detour is to allow for bridge maintenance and repair project at the interchange.

During construction:

- Motorists may experience brief delays
- A 14-foot width restriction will be in place on the detour
- A 12-foot width restriction is in place on the overhead bridge
- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph on the detour

This project is expected to be completed in early October.

The traveling public should use caution when driving through the construction zone. Motorists should allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicles in front of them, use extra caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
