Traffic signal installation work to be completed at several intersections on Hwy 22 in Dickinson

DICKINSON, N.D. (December 3, 2012) – Motorists should watch for flaggers and temporary stop signs as work continues on traffic signals at several intersections on ND 22 through and north of Dickinson. Work will begin this week at the 15th Street intersection.

Work consists of installing the remaining signals and programming the controllers. The project will require temporary shutdown of the signal system at some of the intersections during part of the day. Traffic will be controlled through the intersections by flaggers and stop signs.

Work will be performed at the following intersections on ND 22 during the week of December 3:

- 34th Street SW
- 33rd Street SW
- 32nd Street SW
- Museum Drive
- North I-94 Ramp
- 15th Street West
- 21st Street West
- Walmart entrance.

The project is expected to last approximately two weeks.
