ND Highway 200 closed four miles east of Hurdsfield due to water on the road

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) along with the North Dakota Highway Patrol have closed ND Highway 200 four miles east of Hurdsfield due to water on the roadway. Local traffic only is allowed between the east junction of ND Highway 3 and the west junction of ND Highway 52.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution while traveling, as vehicles that leave the roadway may become immersed in high water.

The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions. Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over the roadway or recede from the roadway.
