Speed limit reminder on ND Hwy 22 north of Dickinson

DICKINSON, N.D. (June 26, 2012) – The North Dakota Department of Transportation would like to remind the public to please follow speed limits through the widening of ND Hwy 22 construction project.

The public is asked to follow the 45 MPH speed limit through the site, as well as the 25 MPH speed limit on the bypass around the Green River Bridge area.

Project Overview:

This construction project includes widening of ND Highway 22 from two to five lanes of traffic from the north end of Dickinson, north to near the Stark/Dunn County line. The Green River Bridge will be replaced to accommodate the five lanes of traffic. The project will also include adding lighting and traffic signals at 32nd Street SW, 33rd Street SW and 34th Street SW.

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
