Public Hearing to be held on February 21, 2013 to discuss Proposed Dickinson Bypass

A Public Hearing will be held from 4:30 p.m. - 7:30 p.m. (MST) on Thursday, February 21, 2013 at the Heart River Retreat Center, 2475 West Broadway, Dickinson, ND 58601. The Public Hearing will utilize an open house format with an open microphone question and answer session following the formal presentation at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to discuss a proposed bypass on the northwest side of Dickinson which will extend from I-94 to Hwy 22. The Public Hearing will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the City of Dickinson, Stark County, North Dakota Department of Transportation and HDR Engineering, Inc. will be present and available to answer questions.
