Federal Highway document for US Highway 85 project around Alexander available for viewing

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) regarding improvements to US Highway 85 around Alexander. In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 it has been determined that the preferred alternative will have no significant impact on the environment. The preferred alternative route for the Alexander Bypass has been identified as Alternative B which would involve realigning US Highway 85 around the west side of Alexander.

This FONSI is based on the January 2013 Environmental Assessment which has been independently evaluated by FHWA and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, environmental issues and impacts of the proposed project, and appropriate mitigation measures.
