Interstate 94 eastbound and westbound lanes have water on roadway three miles west of Jamestown

The North Dakota Department of Transportation announces that both eastbound and westbound lanes of Interstate 94 have water on the roadway approximately three miles west of Jamestown (mile marker 248). Motorists are advised to slow down, watch for signs or flaggers and use caution, as vehicles that leave the roadway may become immersed in water.

NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling. For updated road information, call 511 from any type of phone or go to the Travel Information Map on our website at www.dot.nd.gov.

Please be advised that road condition information on 511 and the travel map is updated daily from 5 a.m. until 9 p.m. CDT.
