Federal Highway document for New Town truck reliever route is available for viewing

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) regarding improvements for New Town northeast truck reliever route. In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 it has been determined that the preferred alternative will have no significant impact on the environment. Alternative I is identified as the preferred alternative route for the New Town northeast truck reliever route. Alternative I consists of a 3.2 mile route that would be constructed along the east side of 87th Ave NW in New Town and running north approximately one mile then turning northwest until it intersects with ND Highway 1804.

This FONSI is based on the February 2013 Environmental Assessment which has been independently evaluated by FHWA and determined to adequately and accurately discuss the need, environmental issues and impacts of the proposed project, and appropriate mitigation measures.
