Traffic reduced to one lane on I-94 west of Grant Marsh Bridge in Mandan for sign replacement

Work begins today to replace an overhead sign on I-94 west of the Grant Marsh Bridge in Mandan. Starting at 7 p.m. tonight the right lane of the westbound roadway will be closed for a few hours to allow for the work.

During the project:

- Speeds will be reduced to 40 mph through the lane closure
- Flaggers will be present

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
