Construction underway on US Highway 2 through Ray

Construction is underway on US Highway 2 from ½ mile east of Ray to ½ mile west of Ray. During construction, traffic will be reduced to one lane where work progresses through the area. This approximately two-mile project consists of adding turn lanes, extending turn lanes, paving, adding a traffic signal at the intersection of US Highway 2 and County Road 17 and adding a pedestrian crossing at the intersection of US Highway 2 and Church Street.

During this period:

- Speeds will be reduced
- Flaggers may be present
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place
- Drivers should expect minor delays

Work is to be completed this fall.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
