Public Information Meeting regarding proposed improvements to James River Bridge on US 281

Tuesday, June 25, 2013, a Public Information Meeting will be held to discuss the proposed improvements to the James River Bridge on US 281 in New Rockford. The meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Brown Memorial Auditorium, 3 7th Street South, New Rockford, ND.

The Public Information Meeting will focus on the proposed improvements to US 281 from 3rd Avenue extending north to the junction of ND 15. The project consists of replacing the James River Bridge, realignment of US 281, turn lane installation at the junction of ND 15 and lighting within the city of New Rockford. Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will be available at the meeting to answer questions from the public.
