Construction begins on Memorial Highway between Bismarck and Mandan

Starting Friday, June 21, construction will take place on Memorial Highway between Bismarck and Mandan. Some of the work is scheduled to be completed during the night to cause minimum disruption to the traveling public. However, work is scheduled to take place during the day on Sunday, June 23, possibly causing delays in traffic. The project consists of microsurfacing work to the roadway.

During construction:

- Some of the work will be conducted at night to lessen the impact to the traveling public
- Lane closures will take place when work is being conducted
- Speeds will be reduced at times
- Flaggers will be present when necessary
- Motorists may experience minimal delays

The project is expected to be complete within a few days, weather permitting.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
