ND Hwy 53 near Benedict has water on the shoulder

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is reporting that ND Hwy 53 near Benedict has water on the shoulder. Traffic is allowed with normal speeds.

The following highways are affected by flood waters, but remain open to traffic, with traffic speeds reduced:

- US Highway 83, nine miles north of Max – Temporary grade raise in place with single lanes of traffic in both directions.
- ND Highway 200, four miles west of Hurdsfield.
- ND Highway 200, four miles east of Hurdsfield - Temporary Grade raise in place with a single lane of traffic.
- ND Highway 14, 12 miles north of Towner water on the shoulder. Traffic is allowed with reduced speeds.

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions.
