## Construction to start August 5 on various intersections in Grand Forks

Starting Monday, August 5, construction will begin on the following intersections along 32<sup>nd</sup> Ave in Grand Forks: 38<sup>th</sup> St., 34 St., 31<sup>st</sup> St., 20<sup>th</sup> St. and Columbia Road. Some of the work is scheduled to be completed during the night to cause minimal disruption to the traveling public. However, some of the work may take place during the day possibly causing delays in traffic. The projects consist of concrete repair work.

During construction:

- Some work will be conducted at night to lessen the impact to the traveling public
- Lane closures will be setup in areas where work is in progress. Lane closures will be frequently relocated.
- Speeds will be reduced
- A width restriction of 12 feet will be in place
- Flaggers will be present
- Alternate route is recommended for oversized loads
- Motorists should be aware of changing conditions throughout the project
- Motorists may experience minimal delays

The project is expected to be complete in September.

Help prevent work zone crashes. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
