1st Ave/US 52 in Jamestown temporarily closed due to railroad crossing work

A railroad crossing construction project will start today, Wednesday, August 7, at 1st Ave/US 52 (between 1st and 2nd Street North) in Jamestown. A segment of US 52 (1st Ave) will be temporarily closed in downtown Jamestown. A detour will be in place during construction. The project work will be done by BNSF railroad.

- Work will take place August 7 through August 9.
- A signed detour will be in place during the closure.

Rear end crashes are the most common in work zones. Motorists are encouraged to slow down, allow extra distance between their vehicles and the vehicle in front of them, use caution and obey flaggers and posted signs.
