Public Input Meeting to be held on October 1, to discuss proposed improvements to Main Street in Williston

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 1, 2013 at the Williston Community Library at 1302 Davidson Drive, Williston, ND. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation at 6:00 p.m.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for Main Street from the junction of Front Street north to the junction of 6th Street in Williston. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. The North Dakota Department of Transportation, city of Williston, and DOWL HKM (Consultant) staff will all be present at the meeting to answer questions regarding the project.
