NDDOT encourages teens to participate in NDTeenDrivers Safety Contest

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) encourages teens to register for the 4th Annual NDTeenDrivers Traffic Safety Contest. North Dakota teens can promote traffic safety in their school and community all while having fun with their friends. Contestants will be asked to create and produce a 30-second video or design a billboard about the topic of seat belt safety. The winning billboard will be displayed across the state and the winning video will air for one week on local television stations and also play for one year at Carmike movie theatres across the state.

The NDTeenDrivers Traffic Safety Contest is open to students, ages 14 to 19 enrolled at a North Dakota middle school or high school. Students may work individually, or in a group of up to five students.

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is the sponsor of the Annual NDTeenDrivers Traffic Safety Contest. Please note, there has been a change to the dates of the contest from previous years. This year's contest started April 11, 2013, and will run through September 30, 2013.
