I-29 OPENED from Fargo to Grand Forks, No Travel Advisories LIFTED

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) and the North Dakota Highway Patrol have **OPENED I-29 from Fargo to Grand Forks**. All **No Travel Advisories** have been **LIFTED** across the state and **Travel Alerts** are no longer in effect.

All travelers are encouraged to monitor road conditions as weather conditions occur and use caution while traveling. For road information, call 511 from any type of phone or go to the website: www.dot.nd.gov. The road report is based upon the information available to the NDDOT at the time of preparation and is provided solely as a public service. Conditions may vary from those reported. Please be advised that road condition information on 511 and the travel map is updated daily from 5 a.m. until 9 p.m. CDT.
