Construction begins today on Washington Street in Grand Forks

Construction will begin today on Washington Street in Grand Forks from 32nd Ave. to 13th. Ave S. The project consists of concrete pavement repair along with the construction of turn lanes. Initial work consists of utility work off the roadway. Starting beginning of June, one lane of traffic will be closed in each direction. Lane closures will be adjusted as the project progresses.

During construction:

- Motorists should be aware of lane closures
- Motorists will experience delays and should plan extra time to reach their destination
- Speeds will be reduced
- Width restrictions of 12 feet will be in place. Oversize loads should take an alternate route.
- Flaggers will be present.
- Motorists should pay close attention throughout the work zone as traffic patterns will change throughout the duration of the project.

The project is expected to be completed by September.
