Construction work to begin today on ND Highway 23 east of Watford City

Construction work will begin today, May 14 on ND Highway 23 approximately two miles east of Watford City near the intersection of ND Highway 23 and ND Highway 1806. This work is part of the Watford City Southeast Bypass project.

During construction:

- Motorists will be detoured onto temporary routes as needed throughout the project
- Speeds will be reduced to 25 mph
- Motorists should expect delays
- A width restriction of 12 feet will be in place
- Flaggers will be present as needed

Construction will be completed in October.
