Water has receded on northbound lanes of US Highway 83 north of Coleharbor

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) is reporting that water has receded from the northbound roadway on US Highway 83 approximately one mile north of Coleharbor and traffic is moving at normal speeds. There is still water in the southbound lanes and traffic is allowed at reduced speeds. Due to high winds, water is also present on sections of ND Highway 256 approximately six miles south of Antler and traffic is allowed with reduced speeds.

Fluctuating water levels make it difficult to predict when and where water will go over a roadway or recede from the roadway. The NDDOT encourages motorists to check road conditions before traveling due to rapidly changing conditions.
