Southbound and northbound traffic to be rerouted beginning today at US 2/85 intersection in Williston

Starting today, crews will shift a work zone at the US Highway 2/85 intersection in Williston. Northbound and southbound traffic will be rerouted and traffic will remain head to head from the intersection to 1,500 feet south of the intersection so that crews can continue paving work in the area. Traffic will continue to be reduced to one lane in each direction for the eastbound, southbound and northbound lanes, with the westbound traffic utilizing two lanes. This work is part of the Williston Truck Reliever Route project.

During construction:

- Speeds will be decreased to 25 mph in some areas
- Motorists should expect delays
- A width restriction of 12 feet will be in place

Paving work in the north side lanes will be completed in mid-August. Work north of the intersection will continue through October.
