ND Highway 1804 traffic in Williston to be detoured today as part of Williston Main Street Reconstruction project

ND Highway 1804 traffic will be detoured onto 2nd Street today, November 18, for crews to install a traffic signal as part of the Williston Main Street Reconstruction project. Work is continuing on Main Street from Front Street East to the East Broadway intersection in Williston. The Main Street Reconstruction project will include replacement of storm drains, sewer, water, sidewalks, landscaping and signal lights.

The detour will be removed on Wednesday, November 19.
