

Public Input Meeting to be held December 8, to discuss proposed improvements to US Highway 52 west of Carrington, ND

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on December 8, 2014, at the Carrington city council chambers located at 103 10th Avenue North in Carrington. The meeting will utilize an open house format.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss proposed improvements for US Highway 52 between the west junction of ND 200 and the east junction of ND 200 at Carrington, ND. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Sambatek and the North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) will be present to answer questions.
