Public Input Meeting to be held on March 23, to discuss proposed intersection improvements along State Street (Hwy 83) in Bismarck, ND

A Public Input Meeting will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Monday, March 23, 2015 at the Ramada Bismarck Hotel, 1400 East Interchange Avenue, Bismarck, North Dakota 58501. The Public Input Meeting will utilize an open house format with a formal presentation beginning at 6:45 pm.

The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss the proposed intersection improvements for State Street from the intersection of Divide Avenue to the intersection of Calgary Avenue, along with the intersection at 11th Street and Century Avenue in Bismarck. The Public Input Meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Representatives from the City of Bismarck, NDDOT, TAIT & Associates, Inc., and HDR Engineering, Inc. will be on hand to answer your questions and discuss your concerns.
