Speeds to be reduced on Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route starting on April 22

Beginning tomorrow, Wednesday, April 22, speeds will be reduced to 25 mph on the Williston Temporary Truck Reliever Route from 140th Avenue Northwest to 143rd Avenue Northwest and between County Road 8 and 62nd Street Northwest to allow construction equipment to enter and exit the roadway. This work is part of the Northwest Williston Truck Reliever Route.

During construction:

- Motorists should expect delays
- Flaggers will be in place
- Motorists are advised to watch for trucks exiting and entering this roadway

The speed reduction will be in place through late June.
