The purpose of the Public Input Meeting is to discuss the proposed improvements of ND Highway 1804 from the 23B Bypass to Mountrail County Road 5. The meeting will provide opportunity for public input. Staff from the NDDOT and Ulteig Engineers, Inc. will be available to answer questions.
