




Burleigh County Structures

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Burleigh County is proposing improvements to three bridges:

-  Bridge replacement on Apple Creek Road, 1/2 mile east of 80th Street Southeast
-  Bridge replacement on 236th Street Southeast, 1/2 mile south of Lincoln Road
-  Bridge removal on 102nd Avenue Southeast, 1/2 mile east of U.S. Highway 83

Construction is anticipated in 2026.

EXISTING CONDITION

- Bridge has been closed since 2022.
- Recommended removal of structure due to low traffic volumes on roadway and nearby connections/access.
- Removal would be a significant cost savings to the county.

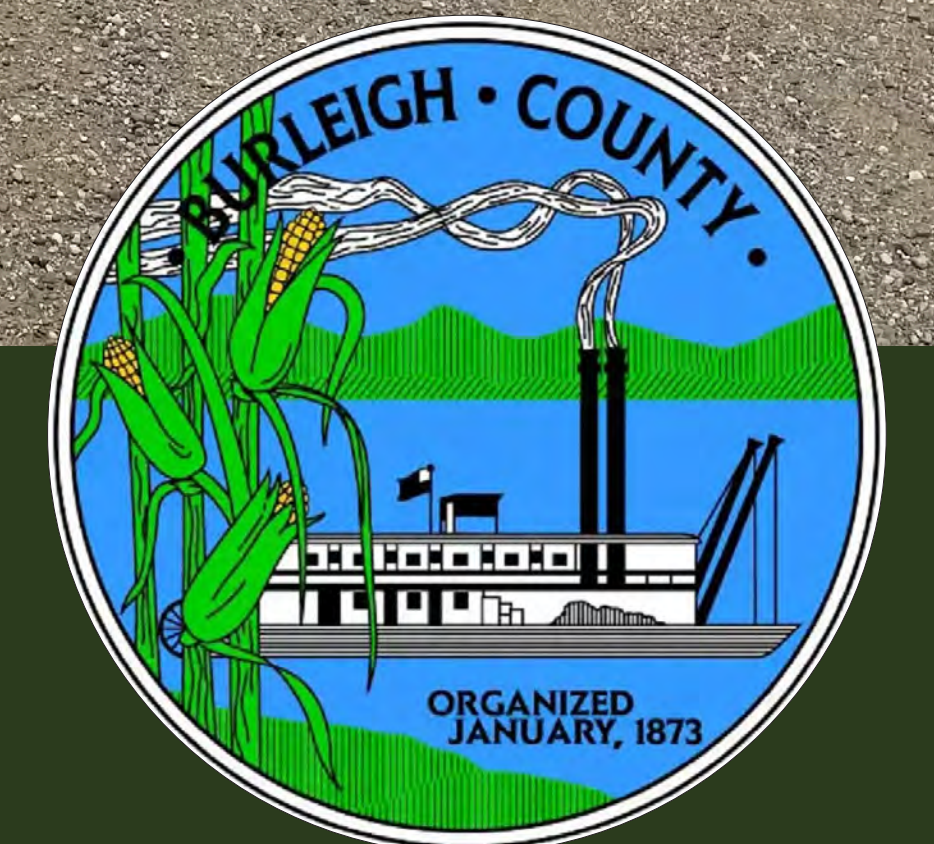


Burleigh County Bridge Replacement

EXISTING CONDITION




- Currently a 33-ft timber bridge built in 1950.
- Load posted for 10 tons.
- Replacement anticipated to be a box culvert.

EXISTING CONDITION

-  50-ft steel girder bridge built in 1965.
-  Currently posted at 6 tons per axle and 37 tons gross.
-  Replacement anticipated to be a bridge.
