<b>Eligible Applicants</b>	State or local governments, transit agencies, (MPOs), or other political subdivisions of a State or local government, or a multijurisdictional group or consortia of research institutions or academic institutions.		
<b>Awarded Funds Use</b>	Funds awarded under the ATTAIN Program may be used to deploy advanced transportation and congestion management technologies.		
<b>Program Description</b>	Up to \$60 million in Federal funding to provide grants to eligible entities to deploy, install, and operate advanced transportation technologies to improve safety, mobility, efficiency, system performance, intermodal connectivity, and infrastructure return on investment.		
<b>Unique Program Items</b>	FWHA will award 5-10 grants, max award of \$12 million. Minimum 20 percent of available funds are reserved for rural areas.		
<b>Eligible Projects</b>	Eligible projects will deploy advanced transportation and congestion management technologies. Full list of eligible projects can be found on pages 9-12 of NOFO.		
<b>Eligible Costs</b>	Costs to deploy, install, and operate advanced transportation technologies to improve safety, mobility, efficiency, system performance, intermodal connectivity, and infrastructure return on investment.		
<b>Additional Information</b>	Cost sharing or matching is required. Maximum federal share of 80 percent. Program Priorities: Economic Impacts, Freight Movement, and Job Creation. Climate Change, Resiliency, and the Environment. Equity, Multimodal Options, and Quality of Life.
