<p>Nomination Submittal Deadline May 19, 2023</p>	<p>This is not a competitive grant. Grant applicants are selected from the nominations.</p>
<p>Eligible Applicants</p>	<p>States, counties, municipalities, other political subdivisions of a state, and tribal nations.</p>
<p>Program Description</p>	<p>Provides technical and financial assistance to state and local governments and U.S. territories to carry out off installation activities in planning, enhancing infrastructure, and implementing measures and projects that contribute to maintaining or improving military installation resilience and/or will prevent or mitigate encroachment.</p>
<p>Nominations</p>	<p>The two primary ways an installation can be nominated for a project, through a Military Department, or a community self-nomination.</p>
<p>Nomination Details</p>	<p>A state or community should submit a self-nomination to the Program Activity Lead that may include the following details: Point of Contact; Description of actual/potential compatibility or resilience issue; A description of the proposed project; A description of the anticipated role of the installation(s) in the plan and concurrence with the proposal. You can self-nominate for an Installation Resilience project by following this process, as outlined on the Office Local Defense Community Cooperation website.</p>
<p>Installation Resilience Program nominations should include</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) a description of how the installation is collaborating with local communities on planning for climate resilience; 2) a prioritization of any locations with mission assurance implications; 3) the status of any related infrastructure or resilience plans for each installation being nominated; 4) the fiscal year needed (FY 2023-2027); and 5) specific resilience issues that need to be addressed in the community.
